## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION

- 1. All applicants for an absentee ballot shall fill out in full the application on the front side of this form and sign it.
- 2. All absentee ballot applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the vote, which is May 14, 2024, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the vote, which is May 20, 2024, if the ballot is to be picked up personally by the voter at the District Office.
- 3. Where a person is or would be, if they were a qualified voter, entitled to apply for the right to vote by absentee ballot under the provisions of Section 2018-b Education Law, their spouse, child or parent, if a qualified voter and a resident of the same school district, shall be entitled to vote as an absentee voter upon personally making and signing an absentee ballot application showing that they expect to be absent from the school district on the day of the school district vote by reason of accompanying or being with the spouse, child or parent who is or would be if they were a qualified voter, entitled to apply for the right to vote by absentee ballot.
- 4. You may request an absentee ballot by mail no earlier than thirty (30) days and no later than seven (7) days before the vote, an absentee ballot application and absentee ballot will be sent to you by mail. In order for the absentee ballot to be canvassed, you must return BOTH the absentee ballot application AND the absentee ballot in the envelope. The absentee ballot must be enclosed in the envelope marked "Statement of Absentee Voter" and the Statement must be signed and dated by the voter.
- 5. The absentee ballot must be received by the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2024.
