Dear Families,

We are incredibly excited to be welcoming back students to Duzine beginning next week. With students returning, we want to provide you with important information relevant to building logistics, the hybrid instructional model, as well as a schedule for the next two weeks of school.

Arrival & Parent Drop-Off

Students begin their day at 9:25am. Parents may begin to drop off their child(ren) at 9:05am. Between 9:05am and 9:35am, all students **must** be dropped off at the circle near the southwest corner of the building. Beginning at 9:35am, late arrivals should enter through the main entrance. Due to the new safety protocol, we can no longer allow parents to enter the building or walk their children to class in the morning.

Upon arrival, all students will have their temperature checked. In addition, parents must complete the district health screening by 8:45am on the days that their child is attending school. Families will be receiving their bus route information from our transportation department.

Breakfast & Lunch

Due to recent federal decisions, the district is able to temporarily provide school meals free of charge to all New Paltz Central School District students, regardless of eligibility or income. This provision will be available through the end of the school year. All students will be offered breakfast in the morning after entering their classroom. Lunch will also take place in the classrooms.

Parent Pick-Up

Students officially end their school at 3:25pm. In order to safely space out dismissal, we will be allowing parents to pick up their child(ren) starting at **3:05pm**. All pick-ups will take place at the gym doors near the old childcare center. A staff member will greet you at the door and have you sign your child out.

Cohort Assignments and Remote-Only Designations

If you are not yet aware of your child's cohort assignment, it can be found in the Parent Portal. Alternatively, you can call the Duzine main office - 845-256-4350 or ask your child's teacher.

Remote-only designations are also in the Parent Portal. Instructions were sent out to parents from our technology office regarding how to access this information. You can also call the main office to confirm whether or not your child has been marked as remote-only.

Hybrid Instructional Model

All Duzine students will receive two days of "live" instruction and three days of asynchronous instruction each week.

For remote-only students, "live" days will involve students logging into a synchronous Google Meet at certain times during the school day. Remote-only students will sign on to synchronous Google Meets during three instructional times during the day: morning meeting, ELA block, and math block. The goal is to limit screen time for remote-only students to 90 minutes each day.

While students from the opposite cohort are at home, they will be doing asynchronous work that the teacher has posted.

Given the unique nature of each teacher's schedule and factors such as the building special area & lunch schedule, teachers will determine what time during the day their ELA and math blocks take place. Your child's teacher will communicate this out to you as soon as this information is available.

Remote-Only Students

If you have chosen for your child to be remote-only, their classroom teacher will communicate with you regarding which days and times their live Google Meets will take place.

Your child's cohort assignment in the Parent Portal reflects the cohort they will be assigned to should you decide your child will be returning to in-person schooling.

A-F Letter Day Cycle

Our letter day cycle will be repeated for each cohort weekly. If a day is missed due to a district holiday, we will skip that letter day.

For example:

School Closures

In the event that there is a school closure or the need for a class to quarantine, classes will pivot to their full-remote schedule that was followed prior to the hybrid return. This includes 90 minutes of daily synchronous instruction.
