Dear Families,

We are incredibly excited to be welcoming back students to Lenape beginning next week. With students returning, we want to provide you with important information relevant to the hybrid instructional model, building logistics as well as a schedule for the next two weeks of school.

Hybrid Instructional Model - Overview

All Lenape students will receive two days of "live" instruction and three days of asynchronous instruction each week.

For remote-only students, "live" days will involve students logging into a synchronous Google Meet at certain times during the school day. Remote-only students will sign on to synchronous Google Meets during three instructional times during the day: morning meeting, ELA block, and math block. The goal is to provide remote-only students 90 minutes of synchronous learning each of those 2 days.

While students from the opposite cohort are at home, they will be doing asynchronous work that the teacher has posted.

Given the unique nature of each teacher's schedule and factors such as the building special area & lunch schedule, teachers will determine what time during the day their ELA and math blocks take place. Your child's teacher will communicate this out to you as soon as this information is available.

Arrival & Parent Drop-Off

Students begin their day at 9:15am. Parents may begin to drop off their child(ren) at 9:15am. Between 9:15am and 9:40am, all students **must** be dropped off at the circle near the northeast corner of the building near the cafeteria. Beginning at 9:40am, late arrivals should enter through the main entrance. Due to the safety protocols, we can no longer allow parents to enter the building or walk their children to class in the morning. <u>Parent Drop Off Map</u>.

Upon arrival, all students will have their temperature checked. **In addition, parents must complete the district health screening by 8:45am.** The health screening can be found on the district home page or by going to this link: https://entry.neric.org/npcsd. It will also be sent prior to each school day as a reminder.

Families will be receiving their bus route information from our transportation department.

As students arrive by bus, their temperature will be taken prior to entering the building. There will be 3 points of entrance for the bus riders to make this process smooth and quick.

Breakfast & Lunch

Due to recent federal decisions, the district is able to temporarily provide school meals free of charge to all New Paltz Central School District students, regardless of eligibility or income. This provision will be available through the end of the school year. All students will have the opportunity to take a bagged breakfast in the morning as a "grab and go" at the 4 points of entrance. Lunch will also take place in the classrooms.

Parent Pick-Up

Students officially end their school day at 3:25pm. In order to safely space out dismissal, we will be allowing parents to pick up their child(ren) starting at 3:00pm. All pick-ups will take place at the cafeteria door at the northeast corner of the building as described by the attached map. As you arrive please stay in your car. A staff member will greet you, have you sign your child out and call in to the cafe to have your child meet you in your car. PLease stay in your car while you wait.

Cohort Assignments and Remote-Only Designations

If you are not yet aware of your child's cohort assignment, it can be found in the Parent Portal. Alternatively, you can call the Lenape main office - 845-256-4300 or ask your child's teacher.

Remote-only designations are also in the Parent Portal. Instructions were sent out to parents from our technology office regarding how to access this information. You can also call the main office to confirm whether or not your child has been marked as remote-only.

A-F Letter Day Cycle

Our letter day cycle will be repeated for each cohort weekly. If a day is missed due to a district holiday, we will skip that letter day.

For example:

In the event that there is a school closure or the need for a class to quarantine, the class will pivot to their full-remote schedule that was followed prior to the hybrid return. This includes 90 minutes of daily synchronous instruction.

If any changes to class assignments are to be made, a letter will be sent out by the end of the day Monday November 9th.
