

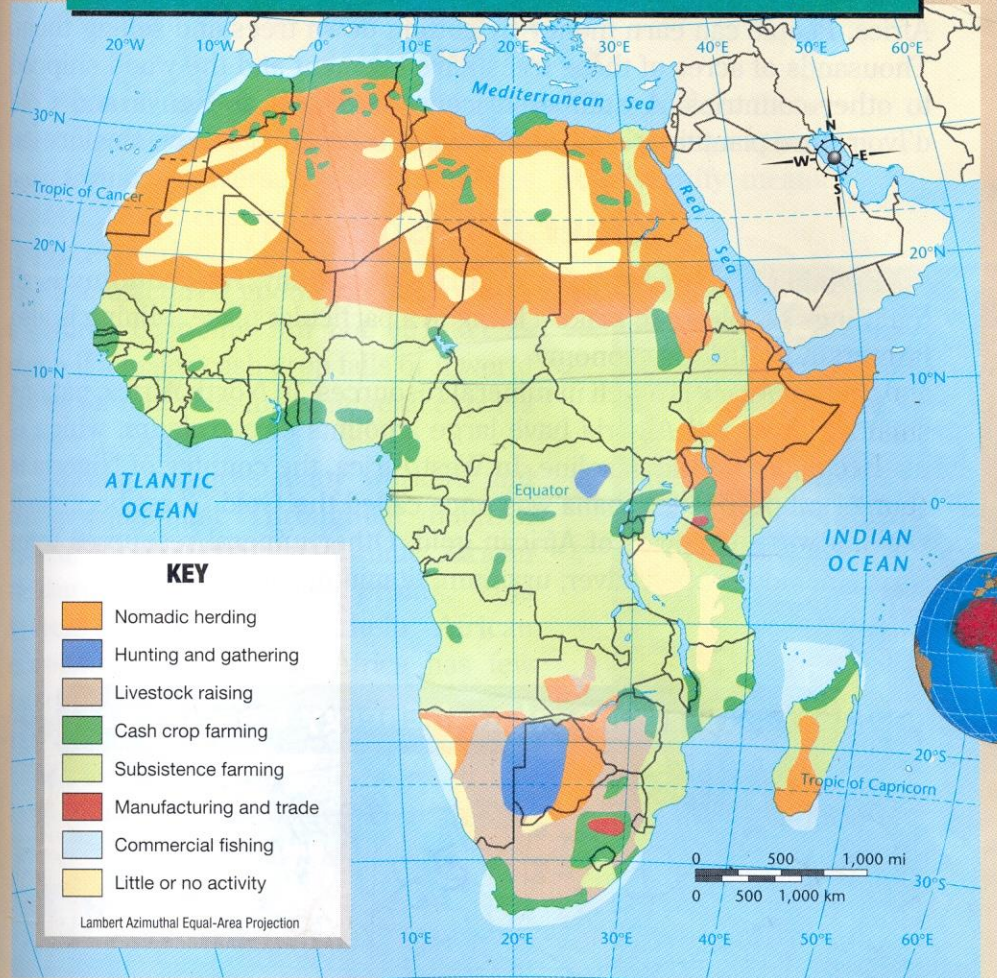
## Africa: Climate Regions



**Map Study** In some of Africa's deserts, children as old as six or seven are amazed when it rains. It rains so seldom in these regions that children may never have seen rain before. In tropical wet regions, it rains almost all the time. But most other regions of Africa have two seasons—rainy and dry. **Location** What climate is most common in Africa along the Equator? What climate is most common near the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn?

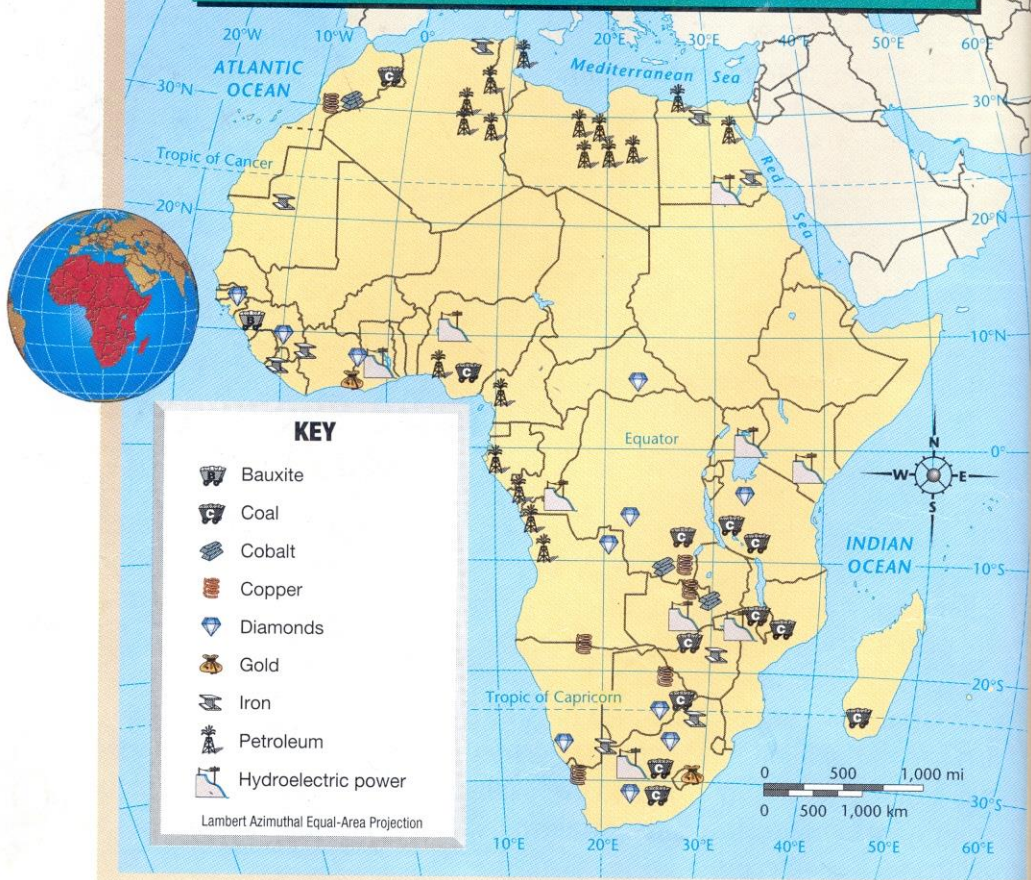


## Africa: How People Make a Living
