The exhibit showcases Rondout, Onteora, New Paltz and Kingston High School student work in traditional darkroom black and white photography. The show opened with a reception, Saturday, April 1st and will remain on view until April 28th.

Starting Sunday, April 9th through Tuesday, April 25th, Studio in Photography students' work will be on display for the annual Elting Memorial Teen Photo Contest. On the evening of April 25th there will be an Awards Reception where top choice in the categories of portrait, landscape and other will be announced and awarded each a \$50 prize. The final three images will be on display for the remainder of that week.

The Alliance for Young Artists and Writers recently announced the 2017 Scholastic Art & Writing Awards National Medalists.
