# New Paltz Middle School Foreign Language Green Screen Studios

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## Rationale

- Offer a creative way to use CI in the foreign language classroom.
- Support literacy in the target language.
- Increase student creativity and involvement with hands on opportunities.
- The need to use technological tools effectively is embedded into every aspect of today's curriculum.
- Students need to integrate multimedia into their schoolwork to the point where they are just as comfortable creating a video piece to get their ideas across, as they are writing a research paper.






## What is Chroma Key?

- A technique for layering two images or video streams together.
- A particular color is removed from the top image so the image behind it shows instead.
- A "green screen" is typically used, as most people do not wear fluorescent green.

- Rehearse, Rehearse, Rehearse


