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A Message From Principal Simms

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Happy Friday NPHS Families,

Five week reports are officially out. Now is a great time to check in with your student to see what supports they may need.

According to the Student Handbook, students must maintain Eligibility in order to take part in school events, clubs, and athletics. Students who are failing two or more classes and/or have excessive absences/tardiness, and/or have engaged in misconduct may lose their eligibility.

ELIGIBILITY — To be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, a student must meet the following criteria in three areas: academic, attendance, behavior. Academic — A student is expected to maintain a passing grade in all subject areas for which they are registered.

Attendance – A student must maintain good attendance.

Conduct—The New Paltz Code of Conduct must be upheld. Students with multiple referrals may become ineligible due to disciplinary record.

Students who are now on the ineligibility list will receive a letter and must complete a contract. We will be working with students and families to get them back on track because we want our students to succeed and take part in all of the wonderful opportunities here at the High School.


