Check out the AMAZING work being done by the many talented students enrolled in Media Arts courses at NPHS LINK TO WORK HERE!

You will see Intro To Media Arts students exploring Line and Shape while also gaining skills in digital drawing and painting using Adobe Photoshop Computer Graphics students had some time to explore their own unique artistic styles in a round of "Free Draw". Students decided on a graphic concept and executed their ideas into reality after several weeks of learning the basic tools and functions of drawing in Adobe Illustrator.

Intro to Film students are quickly learning to become fluent in the skill of KeyFraming for editing in Adobe Premiere Pro. Students first created word art designs using text and effects in Adobe Photoshop, then sent the assets to video layers to become playfully animated into a unique arrangement.

Advanced Film students first round of "Season Specials" projects. These are Senior created projects that are 3-4 episodes in a developed series, the themes and concepts are chosen by students intended to entertain or inform the entire school audience via NPZTV The Morning Show.

Students in both Intro and Advanced Film also created short videos celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month that are shown daily on The Morning Show.

NPZTV The Morning Show is a fun time. Students are encouraged to join the show as news anchors A day's after school, Bring a friend!
