Intro To Media Arts students took a quick trip over to SUNY New Paltz for a tour of the Digital Design and Fabrication lab. They got to see first hand new technologies for 3D printing including full color realistic models, alternate materials along with variable cushioning/density, and how traditional 3D print PLA and ABS are becoming easily recyclable and reusable in house at the lab. Students also were educated on future college paths and careers within the 3D printing industry.
