Two New Paltz High School Students Selected for AFS-USA High School Exchange

Programs in 2024-2025 Academic Year
June, 5, 2024, New Paltz, NY – The AFS NYC Metro & Hudson Valley
Area Team is pleased to announce that Ada Gwynne Anderson and
Nathaniel Johnson, both sophomores at New Paltz High School, have
been selected to study abroad as AFS (www.afsusa.org) exchange
students in the coming academic year. Ada Gwynne Anderson was
selected for the one nationwide spot for a U.S. student to study
abroad in Iceland. She will live with a host family and attend high
school in Iceland during her junior year.

Nathaniel Johnson was awarded a Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange Scholarship, providing full tuition to spend an academic year of study and cultural immersion in Germany. Scholarship recipients serve as "youth ambassadors" as they gain a new perspective on global current affairs and German social, economic, and political life, while learning the German language through language lessons, day-to-day life in the culture, attending a local high school, and living with a host family. In addition to sending students abroad, New Paltz Central School District has a long history of hosting AFS exchange students and this year welcomed two students to the high school: Saki Watanabe from Japan hosted by the Benevento family and Franz Ochmann from Germany who was hosted by Nathaniel Johnson's family for the fall semester only. 
