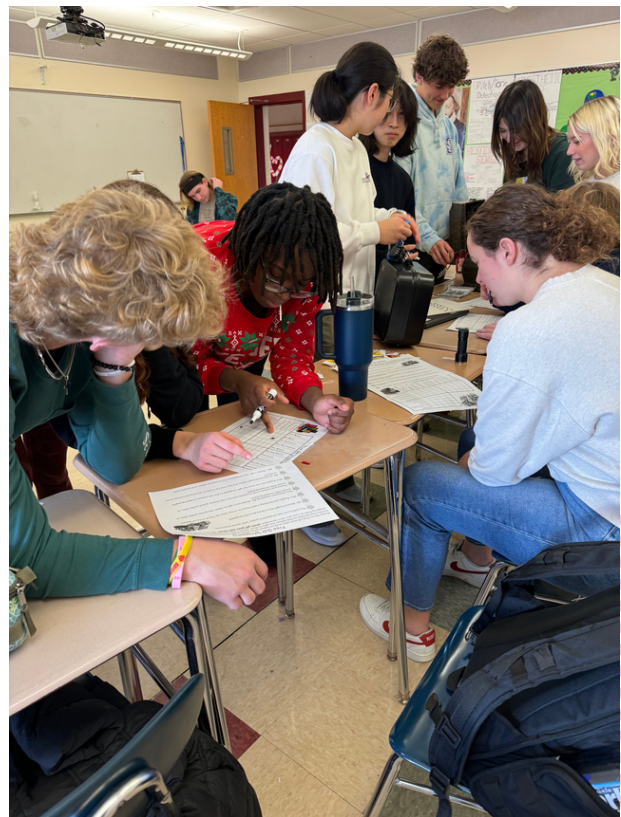


AP EURO
