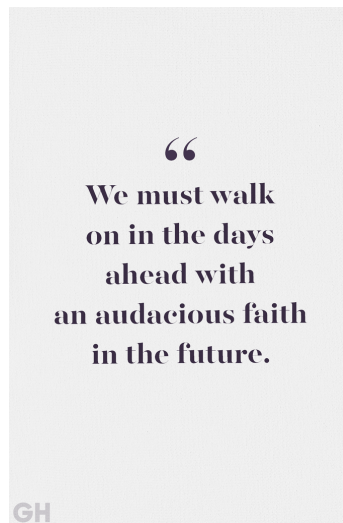

In track and field, the Millrose games are a huge international indoor track championship held in February. World records are broken. International rivalries are fanned.
