Both the stringent Common Core Curriculum and the Annual Professional Performance Review, meant to tie teacher evaluation to State Assessments, contributed to the parent refusal movement. Refusal rates continued to rise even as the Common Core Curriculum was replaced and APPR mandates were revised.
